SUPPLEMENTAL SAVE-25 NARRATIVE APPLICATION

The City of Redondo Beach has been a participant in the Surrendered and Abandoned Vessels (SAVE) program since 2023. Since then, the city has successfully removed and disposed of 9 vessels and spent \$31,457.07 of our \$32,500 SAVE-23 grant award; however, we were unable to use the remaining funds as it was insufficient to cover the full cost of an additional removal. The City exhausted its available funding before we were able to assist every vessel owner or operator who inquired, resulting in eligible requests being deferred due to lack of funds. As part of the SAVE-25 grant application, the City identified 16 vessels ready for surrender totaling \$49,650. Since submitting the application our list is now 19 vessels totaling \$56,650. The City also reserves SAVE funding for our Harbor Patrol, who averages about 4 vessel removals a year from abandoned vessels in the harbor or mooring area. The city has an inquiry form on our website that has generated additional interest in the program. Additional supplemental funds would directly expand the City's capacity to remove eligible vessels and respond to time-sensitive cases. Current funding requires prioritization of only the most at-risk vessels; supplemental funding would expand program reach to more eligible vessels from 2025 into 2026.

The City held a kickoff meeting on January 4th with the 4 marina operators in King Harbor to begin the process of removing surrendered vessels. So far one vessel removal using SAVE-25 funding has been completed and additional vessels queued for removal as follows. Basin 3: two vessels planned for removal (CF 6326GU and CF 0342GD). Portofino Marina: one vessel removed (CF 5238FW) at a cost of \$3,500 and another scheduled in the near future. Port Royal Marina: two vessels planned for removal (CF 9955EE and CF 8568SK) in the immediate future with an additional two vessels in the next few months for a total of four vessels. King Harbor Marina: vessel count is undetermined at this time; the marina reports five vessels currently under liens and the City is awaiting further information to determine which cases will require SAVE-supported removal and/or destruction. Removal costs average \$2,500–\$3,500 per vessel, depending on length. The proposed removals are preventative and time-sensitive because some vessels could present navigational hazards, pollution risks (fuel/oil discharge, debris), and potential sinkings due to winter storms if not addressed promptly.

The City has the staffing capacity and operational readiness to fully utilize supplemental funds well before the September 30, 2027 expenditure deadline as our current list of vessels ready to be surrendered exceeds our current SAVE-25 grant award. Harbor Patrol, Waterfront staff, marina operators, and contracted marine service providers are already engaged in identifying, and removing vessels. The City has demonstrated performance under SAVE-23 and SAVE-25 and proactively removing, documenting, and submitting reimbursement requests and progress reports on a quarterly basis for removed vessels. Supplemental funding would be applied immediately to the next planned removals listed above and, as lien cases resolve, to eligible removals at King Harbor Marina. It would allow the City and marina operators to better expand the program to bring in additional eligible vessels rather than just prioritizing those in the worst condition.
