RESIDENTIAL CONSTRUCTION SITE CRIMES

DETAILS:

In less than two months, there have been seven incidents involving thefts from and bugs to residential construction sites predominately in South Torrance. In one of those incidents, a s-welt was captured on video (see below for description and images).

The crimes are occurring between 0400 and 0500 Hrs, weekends and week days. Tools are most commonly targeted, but appliances have also been taken.

ATTEMPT TO ID: ESTES ROBBERY SUSPECT

Male Black, 50-55 yrs, 5'11" / Thin build
Dark green t-shirt, dark colored jeans, a multi colored "round style hat", black shoes with red laces.
Weapon: Eight inch bladed knife

In Wednesday, July 14, 2021, at 1110 hrs, the suspect entered 3220 W. Century Blvd (99 Cent store). He placed merchandise in two reusable bags. The suspect walked out of the store with the merchandise where he was confronted by an employee. The suspect produced a large knife (see photo above) causing the employee to back away. ATTEMPT TO ID: ARMED ROBBERY SUSPECT

Wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, black jeans, black shoes and a black facemask.

On July 25, 2021, at approximately 0444 hours, an armed robbery attempt occurred at 9830 S Crenshaw Blvd (Arco Gas Station). The employee entered the gas station and was closing the door when the suspect attempted to push his way inside while holding a black handgun. The suspect demanded money from the employee. 
