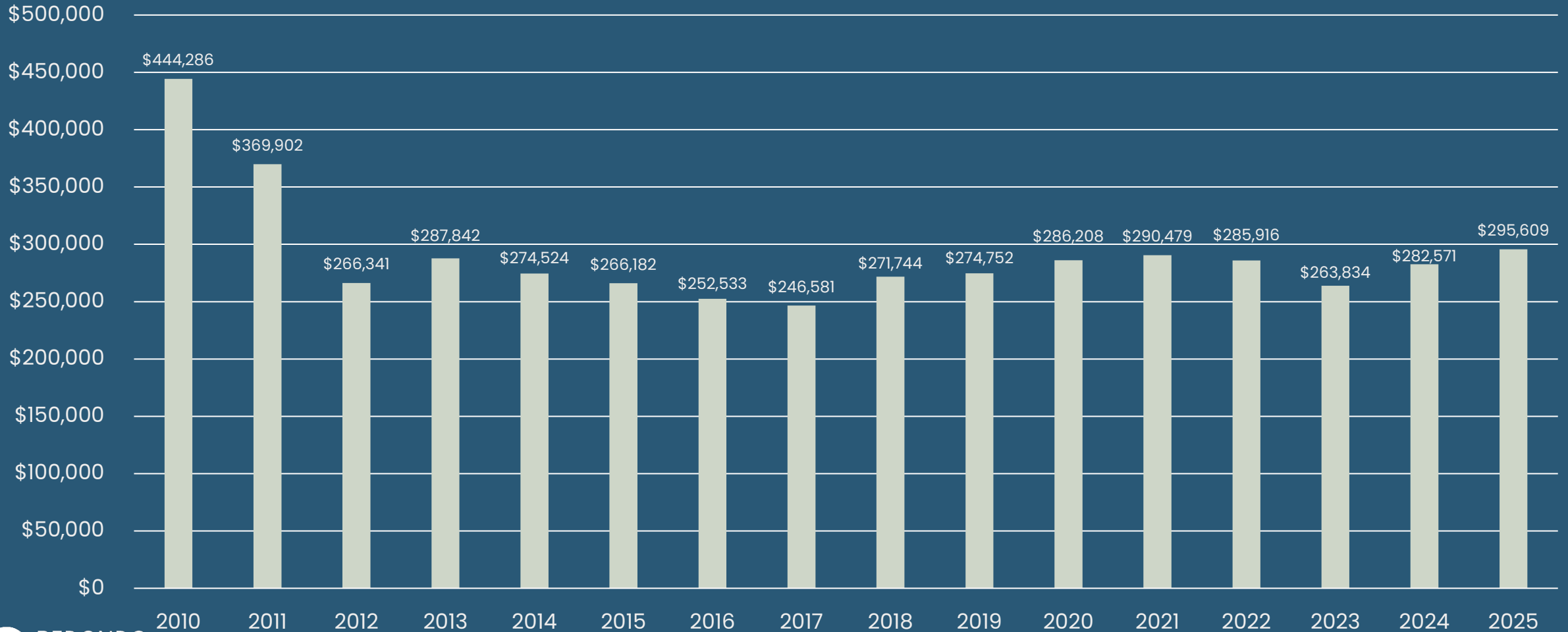

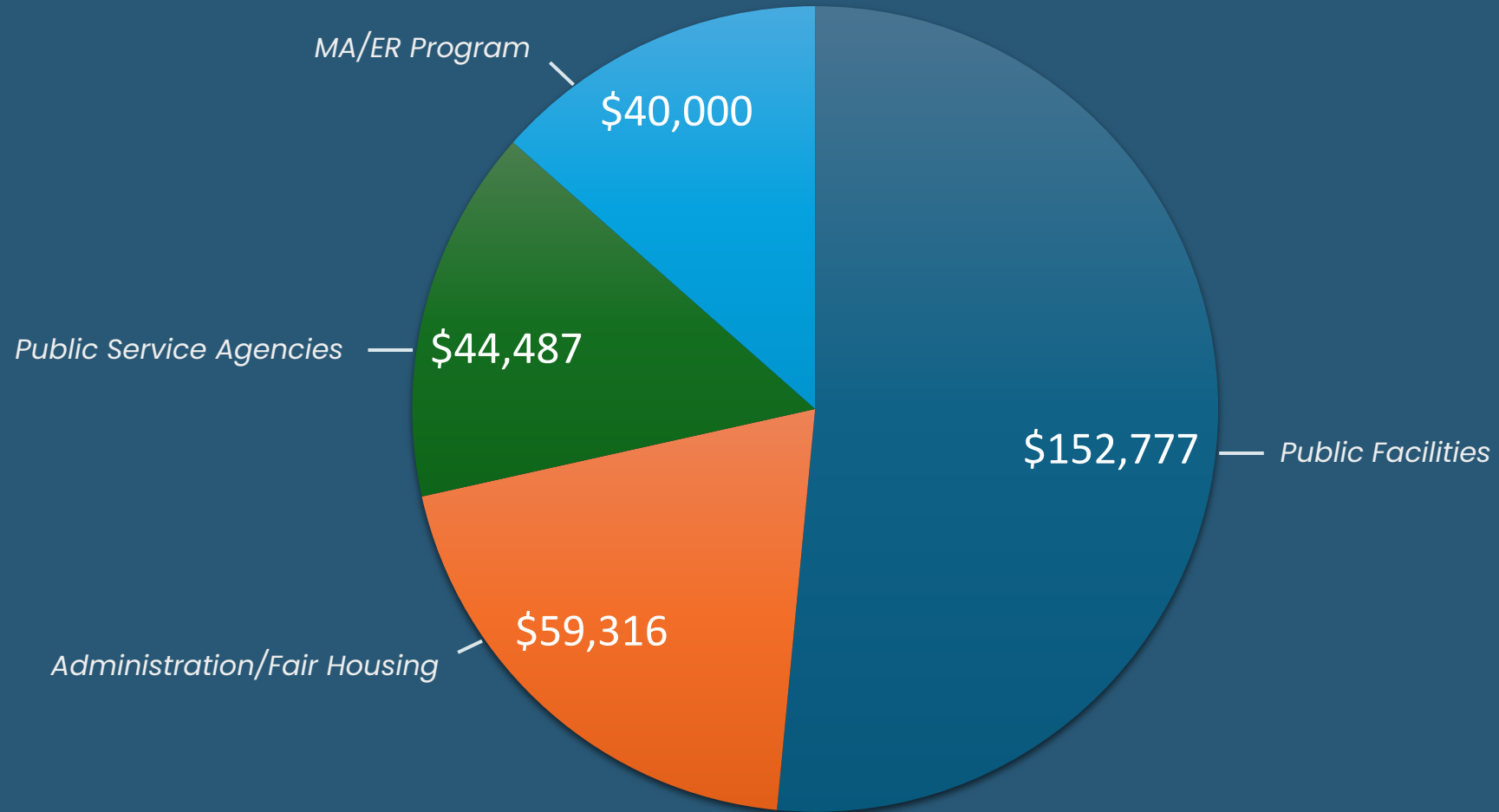

HISTORY OF CDBG FUNDING (2010 to 2025)



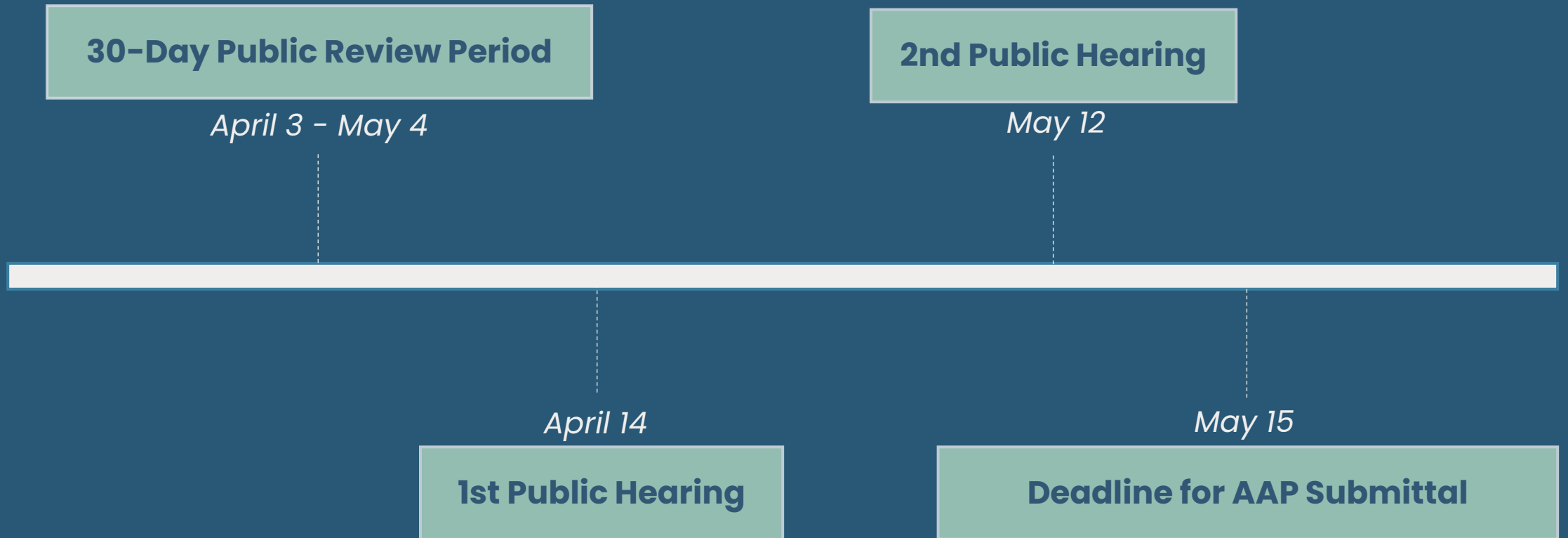
