





ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY
 ESPD Case #21-1827

The Los Angeles Medical Examiner-Coroner is attempting to identify a coroner case 2021-08042 (John Doe #231). On the morning of 7/10/2021 the decedent was found at the bottom of a parking structure located at 830 South Nash Street in El Segundo. The location is a commercial parking lot with cameras that were inoperable since April. The motive of death has yet to be determined as to if he fell, jumped, or was pushed from the top of the structure. Fire personnel pronounced him dead at the scene. It should be noted that his Livescan fingerprints were negative with LASD, DOJ, and FBI.




John Doe #231: Male, unknown race possibly Hispanic or Caucasian, 20-30, 5'6-5'8, 175-185 lbs, front hair bro omie, light moustache & beard wearing a gray T-shirt with "Los Angeles" on front - size XL, "American Apparel" gray sweatpants - size M, "Champion" blue athletic shorts - size L, Adidas, blue underwear, gray tennis shoes - size 11 Adidas, black ankle socks, green baseball cap (FBI)

S/Veh: Gold 4dr sedan, no rear plate.


