





We need additional safety help on Diamond near RUHS ASAP. 100%, or 7 out of 7, residential streets bordering RUHS campus on Vincent have all-way stop signs. Only 50%, or 3 out of 6, residential streets bordering RUHS campus on Diamond have all-way stop signs. Yet, Diamond carries majority of the school related foot and motorized traffic on top of already additional traffic city feeds to Diamond. As such, the Right-of-Way inherently granted to Diamond needs to be scaled back so cars/bikes/people can cross or get onto Diamond safely. This is especially important during school hours and all after-school and weekend RHUS events that bring heavy traffic into the neighborhood. An All-Way Stop at Gertruda or Guadalupe would function similar to the Stop Sign at N Lucia x Del Amo for cars and people that need to cross a busy street near RUHS safely. N Gertruda at Diamond is especially challenging as the intersection sits back/away from Diamond, creating a real

visibility issue for all.
