Proposed Changes

- Change attendance requirement from temporal (60) days, to 3 absences from regularly scheduled commission meetings within a 12 month period of time, subject to compliance with state and federal non-discrimination laws. If a commissioner is absent 3 times in 12 months from regularly scheduled commission meetings, the commissioner shall automatically be deemed to have vacated the seat, and the clerk shall notify the council of the vacancy of the seat.
 - 1. Advanced notice of absence -
 - 2. If a commissioner exceeds maximum number of absences, unless the commissioner sends to the City clerk a statement of petition for reinstatement by the City Council, consistent or like in kind the following: "I petition the City Council to reinstate my commission seat". The aggrieved former commissioner may include a sworn or unsworn statement in support of the petition for reinstatement. The petition for reinstatement shall appear with the former commissioner's statement on the consent calender of next Council Meeting

that has not yet been agendized. If no council member or mayor pulls the consent item and grants reinstatement, inaction by the Council shall be deemed a denial of the petition.

- Commissions may send written reports to Council, which have been adopted by a majority of the commission. Which may be placed on consent. The City Council consent calendar items shall include any reports, writings or recommendations offered by the Commissioners.
- Rudeness by commissioners to city staff will not be tolerated, and is grounds for removal from the commission, Commissioners must conduct themselves on the dais as examples for the public.
 - As an advisory body to the City Council, Commissioners are not to direct staff to perform work. Work assignments should come from the City Manager who is directed by the City Council.
- Commission agenda item shall be changed from Referrals to Staff, to Future Agenda Planning within their purview.
