Urgency Interim Ordinance

- Unanimously approved by Council on May 6, 2025
- 45-day moratorium imposed on the approval of any new smoke shops
- Proposed Extension of Urgency Interim Ordinance No. 3294-25
 - Continue the moratorium for an additional 10 months and 15 days
- Moratorium Status Report included
- Planning Commission to review on July 17, 2025

Recommendation

ADOPT BY TITLE ONLY A 10 MONTH AND 15 DAY EXTENSION OF URGENCY INTERIM ORDINANCE NO. 3294-25 OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH, CALIFORNIA, IMPOSING A MORATORIUM ON DEVELOPMENT OF SMOKE SHOPS IN THE CITY AND DECLARING THE URGENCY THEREOF AND FINDING THE EXTENSION IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT UNDER THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT
