

RESOLUTION NO. CC-2608-061

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$63,627.20 FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL, UNDER THE CANNABIS TAX FUND GRANT PROGRAM; APPROVING THE CANNABIS TAX FUND GRANT PROGRAM AGREEMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Redondo Beach ("City") is interested in participating in the Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program ("Program"), which is made available through the California Revenue and Taxation Code Section 34019(f)(3)(B) and administered by the State of California Department of California Highway Patrol ("CHP") to support enforcement efforts for driving under the influence in the City;

WHEREAS, following the City's submission of a proposal for the Program, the CHP offered to award the City \$63,627.20 for the one-year grant period beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2027;

WHEREAS, the City Council has approved the receipt of previous grant funding for similar police programs;

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used by the City Police Department for overtime costs related to driving under the influence enforcement operations and impaired driving education;

WHEREAS, CHP requires that the City Council adopt a resolution accepting the grant award, approving the Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program Agreement ("Grant Agreement"), and authorizing the Mayor to execute the Grant Agreement; and

WHEREAS, to receive grant funding, the City must submit an executed Grant Agreement to the CHP.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Redondo Beach accepts the Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program award in the amount of \$63,627.20 for the one-year grant program beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2027.

SECTION 2. That the City Council approves the Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program Grant Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and authorizes the Mayor to execute the Grant Agreement on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3. That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant ongoing law enforcement expenditures.

SECTION 4. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and shall enter the same in the Book of Original Resolutions.
