CROSSING GUARD FUNDING

TOTAL COST BREAKDOWN FOR STAFFING

Core Budget

\$212,600

- **12 Sites** with City-Employed Crossing Guards

One-Time Funds

\$343,158

- **Funds 15 Additional Sites**
 - \$205,000: **10 Sites** with City-Employed Crossing Guards
 - \$138,158: **5 Sites** with ACMS Crossing Guards

CITY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE

CONTRACT CONSIDERATIONS

- ACMS requested modifications to indemnity provision.
- City's standard requires full defense, protection.
- ACMS seeks deletion of the word "sole."
- ACMS proposes comparative negligence liability standard.
- Indemnification limit for ACMS set at \$6M.
- CA recommends rejecting requested indemnity modifications.

RECOMMENDED OPTIONS

Option 1:

Approve the Agreement with ACMS to staff five crossing guard locations as currently drafted; or

Option 2:

- Reject ACMS' proposed Indemnity language and demand the contractor accept the City's Standard Indemnity Provision
 - If the Contractor refuses, return on August 19 with a Staff recommendation on which crossing guard locations to vacate
