Project Information

These columns contain general project information: Project Number, Project Name, and Project Type. There are two Project Types: Standalone and Continuous.

Budget Information

These columns contain data from our financial database regarding the appropriations, spending, and available funds for each project.

The data in these columns are from the full lifetime of each project.

Bid Information

These columns contain data from bid documents and Administrative Reports and Resolutions that went to the City Council. Bid Information is only available for projects that had formal bids, grouped in the upper section of the spreadsheet. These columns are lettered A through E to correspond to link columns in the Supplemental Information section to reference the source documents for the data.

Supplemental Information

These columns contain brief clarifying comments and links to publicly accessible source information when possible. The links in letter columns correspond with Bid Information columns.

Comments & Links

Initial Appropriated Amount	The first appropriation for a project allocated through the CIP budget process. This may be seed money, or funds set aside in the hopes that more funds can be accumulated in future fiscal years to execute a desired project.
Subsequent Appropriations	The sum of all additional appropriations allocated towards a project by Council through the CIP budget process, including budget amendments and mid-year budget updates.
Total Appropriations	Initial Appropriated Amount + Subsequent Appropriations
Total Project Spending	The sum of all spending on a project to date.
Total Remaining Funds	Available funds remaining in a project.
A. Engineer's Estimate	The estimated project cost listed in the project's Notice to Bidders for a project's formal bid.
B. Number of Bids Received	Total number of bids received in a project's formal bid.
C. Bid Award	The official amount of the contract awarded to a bidder by City Council following a formal bid on a project.
D. Change Orders	The sum of all change orders under the project contract that was awarded through the formal bid process. Staff may authorize change orders within certain thresholds established by APP 14.01. Beyond those thresholds, change orders must be aproved by City Council.
E. Final Project Cost	Bid Award + Change Orders - Discounts (if applicable) The total expenditures on a formally bid project as represented in the Accept as Complete Administrative Report provided to City Council.
Accept as Complete Council Date	The date a formally bid contracted project went to City Council to Accept as Complete.
