

They've already spent almost \$9,000 on PH in FY23 and nothing on the museum. AS far as I know, Council never gave the HC a mandate to do POH, but they do have a mandate to support the museum.

We told him that months ago. So you watch - he's going to want to use what's left of the \$10,000 in , but I want to use some of that money on furniture (esp. bookcases) for the museum so we can properly store some things, and the Commission identified thousands of dollars of other stuff. I'd tell him he can have 1 sign, but even that will eat up at least \$4,500 which doesn't leave much. I'm preparing an email to Robert now. I'm not sure we've even done the bids and PO stuff for POH

My preference would be to tell him what you told him about the Ito Family Open Space and the signs he wants to put up in Dominguez Park - You'll try to get his projects included as part of those CIPs, but if City Council doesn't fund them, he'll have to come up with the money through his own fundraising.
