- Established in 2006
- Placements in City parks and open spaces
- Donors can select a bench or a tree
- Donors can provide specialty items
- Dedication plaques at each placement location
- Program is self-funding

Proposed Program Updates

- Add the Veterans Memorial engraved bricks as a donation option
- Add the Seaside Lagoon as a donation option for benches and specialty amenities
- Add Czuleger, Andrews and Moonstone (future date) Parks as location options for donations
