

RESOLUTION NO. CC-XXXX-XXX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY MEASURE X, RELATING TO AN INCREASE IN THE UNIFORM TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX (TOT), AT A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MARCH 2, 2027, AS CALLED BY RESOLUTION NO. CC-XXX-XXX.

WHEREAS, Article XIII C of the California State Constitution requires that local governments submit tax measures to voters at a regularly scheduled election of the local governing body; and

WHEREAS, Redondo Beach City Charter Article IVIII, Section 18 states that General Municipal Elections shall be held in the City on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in March in each succeeding odd-numbered year; and

WHEREAS, this schedule would result in the next Redondo Beach General Municipal Election taking place on March 2, 2027; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to submit to the voters at the election a question relating to an increase in the Transient Occupancy Tax from 12 percent (12%) rate of tax to an amount not to exceed fifteen percent (15%), effective at a date to be established by Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redondo Beach called for an election to be held on March 2, 2027 for the purposes of placing a municipal taxation measure and other City of Redondo Beach measures before voters as called by Resolution No. CC-XXXX-XXX on _____, 202__;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council, pursuant to its right and authority, does hereby order submitted to the voters at a General Election on March 2, 2027, the following question:

MEASURE X “To maintain critical City services, such as street and pothole repair, police and fire 911 emergency response and preparedness, park and landscape maintenance, senior and youth recreation programs; and for general government use; shall the City of Redondo Beach Ordinance raising the transient occupancy tax, paid only by hotel and lodging guests, from 12% to up to 15%, providing an estimated \$750,000 of revenue annually per 1% increase, and all funds staying local, be adopted?”	YES

SECTION 2. That the proposed complete text of the Ordinance submitted to the voters is attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 3. That in all particulars not recited in this Resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

SECTION 4. That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in the time, form and manner required by law.

SECTION 5. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and shall enter the same in the Book of Original Resolutions.
