## Active Subcommittees

<b>Facility User Subcommittee</b>	<p>Developed to create enhanced communication between the City and nonprofit groups that utilize the City's parks, facilities, and open spaces.</p> <p><i>[Meets quarterly • valuable communication tool]</i></p>
<b>Park Ranger Subcommittee</b>	<p>Developed to research and analyze whether the commission should recommend to the City Council the establishment of a Park Ranger program.</p>
<b>Volunteer Acknowledgement Program Subcommittee</b>	<p>Members review volunteer acknowledgement applications to determine whether the Commission should consider acknowledging individual or group volunteer efforts.</p> <p><i>[Two pending applications for review]</i></p>
<b>Pickleball Subcommittee</b>	<p>Developed to research and analyze the implementation of pickleball courts throughout the City.</p> <p><i>[Was created prior to the City Council's recent action regarding Alta Vista and Aviation Parks, so it's continuation may no longer be necessary.]</i></p>
