CDBG Program

The City receives an annual allocation of CDBG entitlement funds for eligible housing and community development programs.

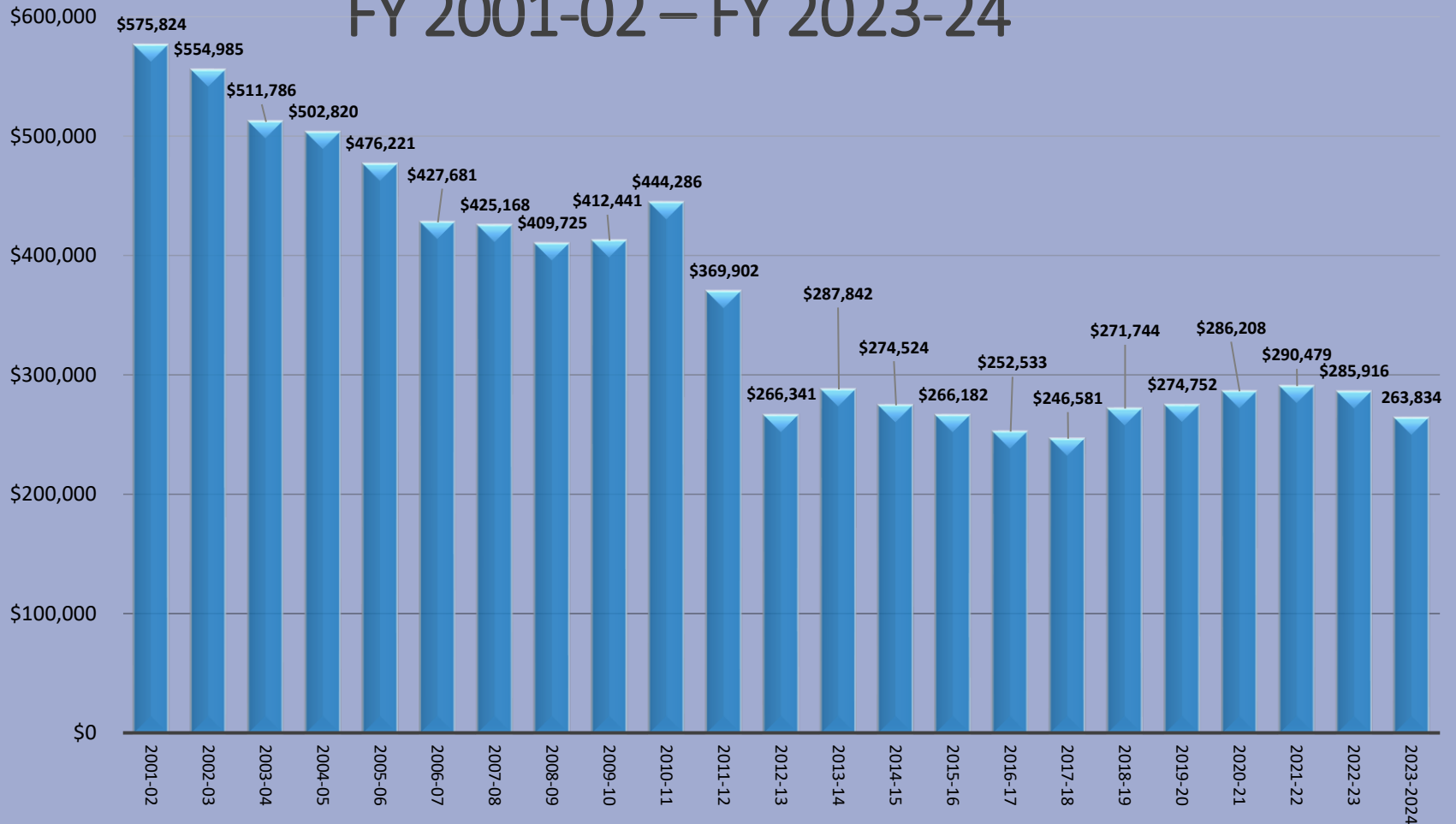
It is expected to receive \$237,451 in CDBG funds by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

The City is required to complete an Annual Action Plan prior to HUD funding appropriation.

Annual Action Plan

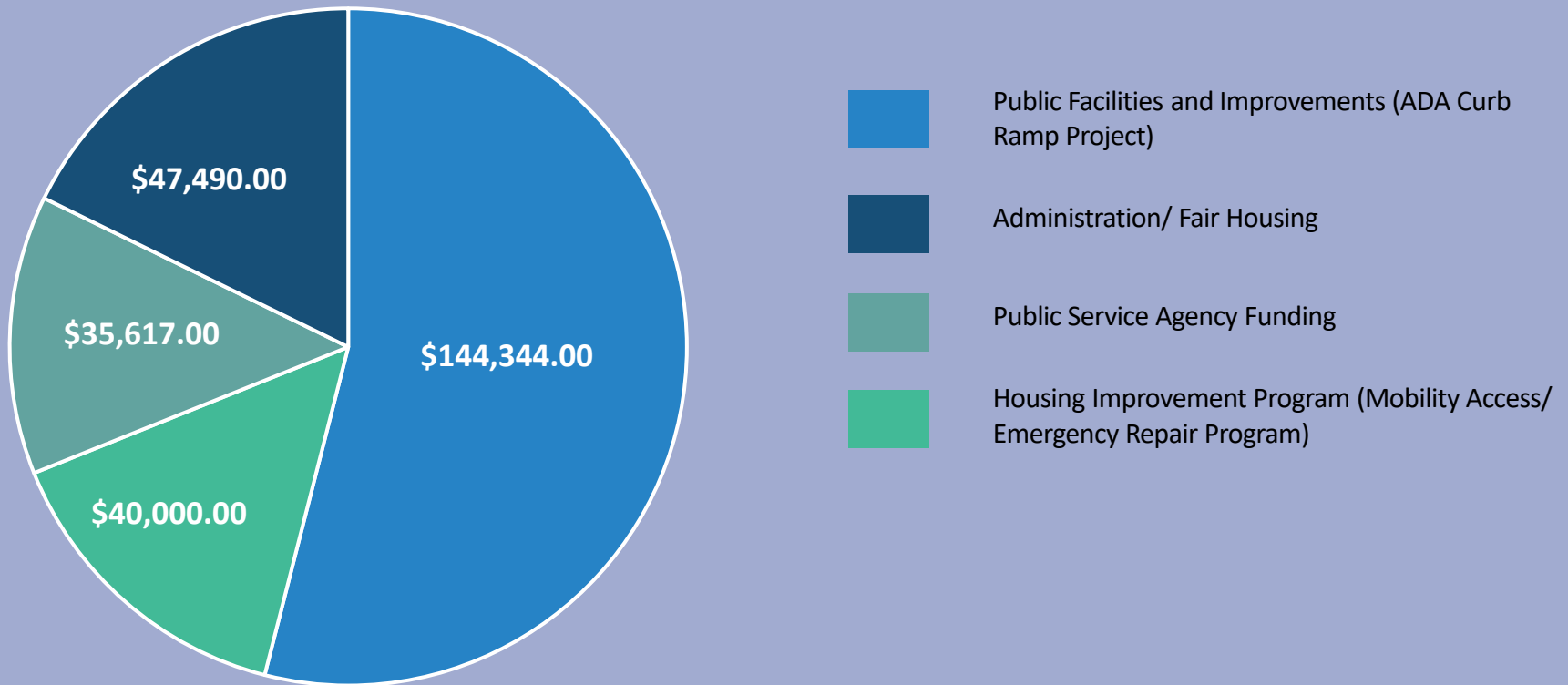
The purpose of the Annual Action Plan is to identify the City's housing and community development needs, strategies, and goals to stipulate how CDBG funds will be allocated for FY 2024-2025.

Public Service Agencies and Proposed Funding

- **1736 Family Crisis Center (\$10,685)** – Provides counseling, support, and referral services to women and youth who are victims of domestic violence.
- **Venice Family Clinic (\$7,480)** – Provides therapy, parenting, crisis interventions, domestic violence counseling, substance use therapy, and Medication-Assisted Treatment to individuals coping with impact trauma.
- **St. Paul's United Methodist Church – Project: NEEDS (\$9,972)** - Provides meals to those individuals experiencing homelessness and food stress; coordinates with City Homeless Services for Coordinated Entry System (CES) processing.
- **Disability Community Resource Center (\$7,480)** - Support people with disabilities and seniors to achieve and maintain self-directed and community based independent lives.

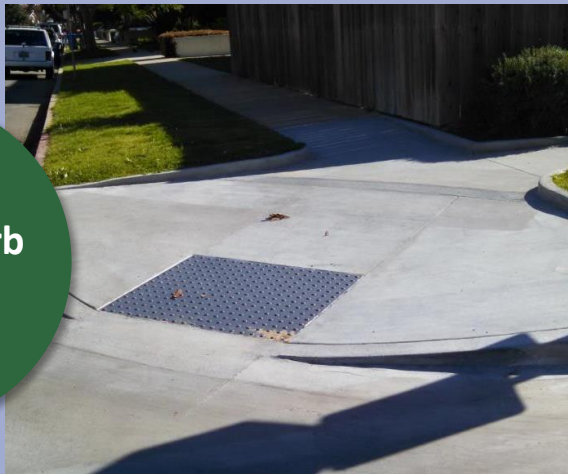

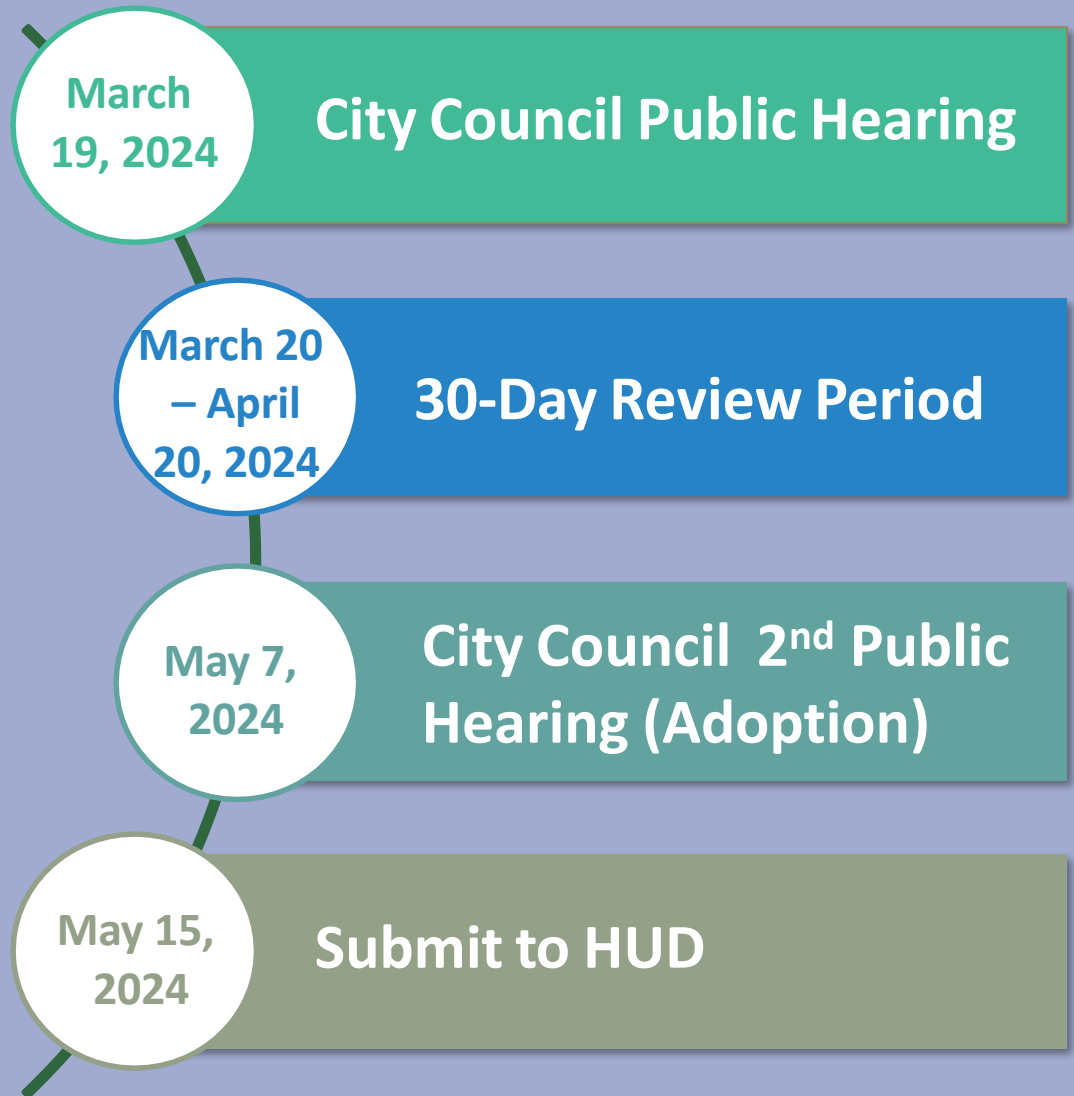
