SUBCOMMITTEES

- Non-Brown Act body – can meet as needed
- Created for a specific role outlined by the commission at the time of formation
- Maximum of 7 commissioners may serve on a subcommittee at a time
- No limit to the number of subcommittees you may serve on
- Bulk of work is completed by the subcommittee with support from staff
- Subcommittees typically provide regular updates to the commission outlining any work they have accomplished
- Final recommendation(s) on assigned topic come from the subcommittee


SUBCOMMITTEES

Where possible, determine any subcommittees needed to accomplish the goals of the commission.


