Curtis, who is a 290 registrant, was released from prison on 8/29/2021, after serving a 12 year term. On 9/03/2021, he was seen in the alleyway that is behind the St Lawrence Martyr School. The school's custodian recognized Curtis from an incident that OCCR 10 years ago, where Curtis was harassing the school children. When told to leave, Curtis became combative. Curtis is currently homeless and may still be in the South Bay area. Curtis failed to report to his parole agent and has a Warrant for his arrest.


