

I have had the privilege of living on the Esplanade between Avenue A & C for the past six years. My apartment directly faces the street which provides me a view of our beautiful ocean. However, during the past year, I've also had the "privilege" of viewing the following occurrences on my street:

A neighbor's home being broken into at 11 AM. She screamed and citizens who walking by tackled the perpetrator

- I've witnessed domestic assaults, drug deals, teens getting high in vehicles, a baby left on the sidewalk in her car seat at 2 AM crying for an hour while her parents were drinking. I've seen sexual acts take place on the sidewalk and in cars, and I've had the pleasure of listening to blaring music from parked cars all hours of the day and night.

What I would rather see is police presence! This is a high traffic area with a lot of visitors. Why aren't police monitoring the area on a consistent basis?

I used to feel safe walking my dog at night. I don't anymore. I used to feel safe having my 8th grade boys meet their friends at the park. Not anymore. I used to feel safe coming home by myself after 10 PM. Not anymore.

I have phoned the emergency and non-emergency RB police numbers numerous times. I have been told officers will come when they aren't busy and by the time they do arrive the damage is done and the people have left.

Summer is approaching-Camps and JG will start soon. Please have police presence in the area for the kids!

A woman who lived on the Venice Canals was almost beaten to death last week while entering her home. Afterwards, the police put out a notice to the community stating that there will be more presence in the area.

Let's not wait for something like this to occur in our city. Don't we have money to have a patrol car in the area? As an aside: If an officer WAS patrolling the area the city would make a lot of money citing speeding tickets! Finally, having parking patrol randomly visit after 10 pm is ineffective. They don't exit their vehicles and instead yell from their car speakers for people to move. This disturbs and wakes up residents. The community deserves better and THE COMMISSION NEEDS TO DO BETTER!
