

**RESOLUTION NO. CC-2607-046**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING A FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027 BUDGET MODIFICATION TO APPROPRIATE \$260,000 FROM THE SOUTH BAY CITIES COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL GRANTS FUND FOR MOTEL STAYS AND SINGLE ROOM OCCUPANCY (SRO) BEDS**

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Redondo Beach (“City Council”) to review the adopted budget from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redondo Beach’s adopted budget needs to be modified to appropriate monies to fund necessary expenditures; and

WHEREAS, as a regional administrator, the South Bay Cities Council of Governments (SBCCOG) receives homelessness funding, including revenues from Measure A, the Los Angeles County half-cent sales tax approved by voters on November 5, 2024, which repealed and replaced Measure H to provide continuous funding for housing and services to address homelessness; and

WHEREAS, on March 25, 2025, the County of Los Angeles Board of Supervisors adopted the Local Solutions funding (LSF) formula as part of the Measure A requirements, allocating funds based on ninety percent (90%) of a region’s two-year average Point-in-Time Homeless Count, and ten percent (10%) of a region’s low-income population percentage; and

WHEREAS, under these formulas, the SBCCOG is projected to receive \$3,048,204 in the first program year (FY25/26); and

WHEREAS, the SBCCOG is projected to receive \$3,173,701 in Measure A LSF funding for FY26/27; and

WHEREAS, in addition to LSF funding, the SBCCOG, as an eligible jurisdiction per SB 679, will receive from the Los Angeles County Affordable Housing solutions Agency (LACAHS), anticipated at approximately \$11 million annually to support (1) housing production, preservation, and ownership; (2) renter protection and homeless prevention; and (3) technical assistance; and

WHEREAS, from these funding sources, the SBCCOG is granting the City \$260,000 for Single Room Occupancy units and Motel beds; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously approved the receipt and appropriation of past funding for similar programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the amounts allocated in the budget of Fiscal Year 2026-2027 and the amounts required to meet conditions which have arisen during the budget year require a modification in the budget appropriation; and, upon recommendation of the City Manager, the budget appropriation as adopted for Fiscal Year 2026-2027 is modified as follows:

Two hundred and sixty thousand (\$260,000) in LSF and LACAHSAs funds from the SBCCOG shall be appropriated to the Intergovernmental Grants Fund for Single Room Occupancy units and Motel Beds.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to Section 11(f) of the City Charter, the City Clerk is hereby directed and instructed to correct the budget records of said City for Fiscal Year 2026-2027 in accordance with the above modification.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and shall enter the same in the Book of Original Resolutions.
