For clarification of this request, City Manager Witzansky stated that a 4/5ths vote may not be required, as the discussion may be about how to allocate and use the budgeted funds. The City Manager was given discretion to determine when it will be appropriate to present this item.

Motion by Councilmember Obaji, seconded by Councilmember Kaluderovic, and approved by voice vote to add the agenda item to a City Council agenda.
