## **ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION PRIOR TO ACTION**

Liaison Aguirre welcomed Emery Chen from Beach Cities Health District.

Emery Chen is the Youth Services Manager at Beach Cities Health District. His Youth Advisory Council is comprised of 85 middle and high school students from Hermosa, Manhattan and Redondo Beach schools and is a youth-led committee focusing on health and well being here in the beach cities. They raise awareness and provide recommendations on health issues specifically affecting youth in the beach cities. They presented a PowerPoint presentation entitled: PhotoVoice Youth Perspective of Alcohol Use in the Beach Cities.

Alex Jeffords is a student member of the Youth Advisory Council and joined in the meeting after the presentation. Alex has been on the Youth Advisory Council for two years and is currently a student leadership member and a junior at Mira Costa High School. They have conducted roundtables/fishbowls with the organization MADD (Mothers Against Drunk Driving) and attended a TUPE (Tobacco Use and Prevention Cessation) Youth Leadership Conference, run by LA Unified School District. They also have initiated a type of telephone tree to check in on all the students from a mental health standpoint during the pandemic. This program is referred to as "Peer to Peer Check-ins". The Youth Advisory Council meets monthly during the school year and focuses on two primary issues: mental health and substance abuse.

The Commission thanked Emery Chen and Alex Jeffords for attending this evening and presenting the PowerPoint presentation that the Youth Advisory Council compiled and narrated.

Liaison Aguirre mentioned that commission applications are being accepted until June 15 so he will send the current applications out to Commissioner Branche and Commissioner Lee for them to review and schedule interviews. There are currently three new applications submitted.

Adult Commissioner Gamet asked for clarification that this commission is advisory to the City Council. Liaison Aguirre confirmed that this commission is able to make any pertinent recommendations to the City Council for action.
