



Question:

What is the status of the Ito Family Park dedication plaque/monument project?

Response:


In 2021, the Historical Commission requested the Public Art Commission consider the installation of a historical mural or art installation at the Ito Family Open Space, located on the corner of Ripley Avenue and Flagler Lane. This installation would focus on art and history, specifically in celebration of the park's namesake, the Ito family. The Public Art Commission assigned this task to the Mural Subcommittee and then later to the Historical Commission Liaison group who developed a preliminary conceptual plan that includes select plants, trees, monument pieces, signage and fencing.



This conceptual plan was provided as an update at the Public Art Commission's June 1, 2022 meeting. A formal review and discussion of the conceptual plan was provided to the Public Art Commission at its July 27, 2022 meeting. Overwhelmingly, the Public Art Commission was in support of the concepts and overall design of the park. The Historical Commission reviewed the recommended conceptual plan at its August 17, 2022 meeting and similarly, supported the work and park enhancements provided by the liaison group.

The conceptual plan was then presented to the Recreation and Parks Commission at its regular meeting on October 12, 2022. The commission fully supported the concept and requested that there be community outreach efforts implemented when finalizing the design to ensure updates to the park meet the needs of regular park users and are consistent with the cultural theme.

Recently, a plaque was installed at the park to commemorate the Ito family and the naming of the park in their honor. The plaque language and format were prepared by the Historical Commission.



Should the City Council want to move forward with the full renovation of the park, preliminary funding would be required to develop the final design. The cost to design and prepare construction plans and specifications for the proposed project is estimated to be \$50,000 to \$75,000. The cost to construct the proposed project (depending on the final design) is estimated to be \$400,000 to \$800,000.
