I am here tonight because I received a notice to cease hosting travelers and guests through Airbnb.

I am a retired teacher and recently divorced. Airbnb supplements my teacher's retirement income and helps me pay my mortgage.

In my small 2 bedroom house in North Redondo, I serve guests who are visiting their children and grandchildren or elderly parents, and people who are traveling on to other parts of the US and are learning about our area. I offer a friendly, warm environment for guests from all over the world.

I understand asking non-resident occupied houses to cease short term rentals, but for hosts who live in the same house, I believe we can find a local approach that allows responsible hosts to operate.

I ask the Council to consider a **regulated Short-Term Rental program** for residents who let out rooms in their permanent residence.

We can include mandatory registration, a local 24-hour contact, occupancy and parking rules. We can require a home business permit.

This approach preserves public safety and neighbor quality-of-life while generating local revenue, supporting our small businesses that rely on visitors.

I am prepared to work with staff, neighbors, and business owners on a pilot program that addresses prioritizing **primary residences**.
