Hello,

On the topic of Beach Cities Transit, are there any plans to (1) simplify service on Line 109 at Plaza El Segundo and Manhattan Village Mall, as well as (2) shorten Line 109 to Redondo Beach Pier with Line 102 being extended to Riviera Village? Aside from the LAX/Metro Transit Center reroute (which will be done in two phases according to the BCT website), these aforementioned route changes were recommended/approved according to the 2022/2023 Service Study Plan which details changes to the Beach Cities Transit system within the next 5 years.
