

## PUSH BUTTON IGNITION BYPASS



KEY FOB

OBD SCANNER      ELECTRIC KEY PROGRAMMER

**Items needed to steal a push button ignition Kia or Hyundai**

1. A mobile mechanics on-board diagnostics (OBD) scanner with the immobilizer application or an electric key programmer.
2. A blank smart key (keyless fob) for the year range of the vehicle to be stolen.
3. A pin code that is specific to your vehicle. The pin code can be obtained through several websites ([Onlinekeycodes.com](http://Onlinekeycodes.com) or [Superpincodes.com](http://Superpincodes.com)) without verification credential. Pin numbers needed for smart keys and key cut codes can be obtained on these sites by using the vehicle vin number.

When the thief forces the driver door locked cylinder, rotating it toward the unlock position, it breaks the internal parts of the lock cylinder. If rotated far enough, it ends in the "unlocked" position and unlocks the door. This causes the vehicles electronic control unit (ECU) to believe the lock was opened with a key and disables the manufacturers' anti-theft systems (honking horns and or flashing lights).

Once inside, the thief exposes the OBD port and plugs in the OBD scanner. The scanner will allow them to access the ECU (computer) and bypass the vehicles ignition immobilizing technology.

Once the ECU has been prompted, the black smart key is pressed against the vehicles start button and used to depress the button once. This will instantly program the smart key to the ECU of the vehicle. The smart key made by the thief will continuously operate and give access to the vehicle because it is now a duplicate. Manufacturers have set no limit on the number of keys that can be made for a single vehicle.


