

Measure TL (Term Limits for City Councilmembers)

MEASURE TL (Term Limits)

PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT

Limits a person from serving more than three full terms as a member of the City Council. City Councilmembers are currently limited to two full terms of service.

Ballot Question:

“Shall the Redondo Beach City Charter be amended to limit a person from serving more than three full terms as a member of the City Council, effective June 2, 2029?”

Proposed Charter Amendment Language:

Article XXVI, § 26 Mayor and City Council.

No person shall serve more than ~~threetwo~~ full terms as Councilmember from any combination of districts, or more than two full terms as Mayor. If a person serves a partial term in excess of two years, it shall be considered a full term for the purpose of this provision. Previous and current terms of office shall be counted for the purpose of applying this provision to future elections although all persons presently in office shall be permitted to complete their present terms.

Effective June 2, 2029.

Measure TL (Term Limits for Members of the Redondo Beach Board of Education and City Council)

**MEASURE TL (Term Limits)
PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT**

Limits a person from serving more than three full terms as a member of the Board of Education, or City Council. Members of the Board of Education and City Council are currently limited to two full terms of service.

Ballot Question:

“Shall the Redondo Beach City Charter be amended to limit a person from serving more than three full terms as a member of the Board of Education, or City Council, effective June 2, 2026, and June 2, 2029, respectively?”

Proposed Charter Amendment Language:

Article XVI , § 16.7 Term limits.

No person shall serve more than ~~three~~**two** full terms as a member of the Board of Education or any predecessor or successor entity covered by this Charter, whether elected at-large or by district or by a combination thereof. If a person serves a partial term in excess of two years, it shall be considered a full term for the purpose of applying this provision. Previous terms and current uncompleted terms of office of persons who were members of the Board on March 3, 1997, shall not be counted for the purpose of applying this provision.

Effective June 2, 2026.

Article XXVI, § 26 Mayor and City Council.

No person shall serve more than ~~three~~**two** full terms as Councilmember from any combination of districts, or ~~more than two full terms as~~ Mayor. If a person serves a partial term in excess of two years, it shall be considered a full term for the purpose of this provision. Previous and current terms of office shall be counted for the purpose of applying this provision to future elections although all persons presently in office shall be permitted to complete their present terms.

Effective June 2, 2029.
