

RESOLUTION NO. 2021--PCR-*****

A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH, CALIFORNIA, FINDING THAT THE PROPOSED 2021-2026 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CIP) IS CONSISTENT WITH THE ADOPTED GENERAL PLAN OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH, AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 65401 OF THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNMENT CODE

WHEREAS, Section 65401 of the California Government Code requires that the "Planning Agency" (i.e. Planning Commission) of a municipality review any Capital Improvement Program (CIP) within its jurisdiction for conformance with the adopted General Plan for the jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, at its meeting of June 17th, 2021, the Planning Commission of the City of Redondo Beach reviewed the proposed 2021-2026 CIP for the City as to its conformance with the adopted City of Redondo Beach General Plan; and

WHEREAS, the projects proposed reflect the need for public roadways, public utilities and other community facilities during the next five-years in concert with the provisions of the General Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The proposed 2021-2026 CIP for the City of Redondo Beach is consistent with the adopted General Plan for the City of Redondo Beach, pursuant to Section 65401 of the California Government Code.

SECTION 2. The Planning Commission shall forward a copy of this resolution to the City Council so the Council will be informed of the action of the Planning Commission.
