# LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

## Coastal Access & Preservation

- Collaborate with State Agencies
- Support funding initiatives
- Preserve public coastal resources
- Defend local control



# LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

## Economic Development

- Restore redevelopment tools
- Boost local tourism & investment
- Promote local trade & innovation
- Protect regional assets



# LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

## Employee Relations

- Preserve local authority in labor relations
- Support CalPERS reforms for transparency & cost containment
- Maintain integrity of local pension agreements



# LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

## Environment

- Secure environmental funding
- Promote water reliability
- Support local waste management
- Reject unfunded mandates



# LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

## Finance

- Promote fiscal sustainability & local authority
- Preserve critical funding programs (CDBG, Section 8)
- Support infrastructure & municipal operations
- Defend municipal bond tax-exemption



# LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

## Homeless & Mental Health Services

- Support integrated services
- Promote collaborative response models



# LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

## Housing

- Secure housing funds
- Protect local authority



# LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

## Library & Recreation Services

- Support library & recreation programs
- Protect access to information
- Expand digital inclusion



# LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

## Public Safety & Emergency Preparedness

- Fund critical services
- Upgrade public safety technology
- Ensure safe micro-mobility (e-bikes)
- Protect local revenues



# LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

## Telecommunications

- Preserve municipal control
- Oppose restrictive proposals



# LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

## Transportation

- Increase local funding
- Protect local planning control
