

RESOLUTION NO. CC-2604-021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING RETIRED CALPERS ANNUITANT DAVID BIGGS TO PERFORM SERVICES AS AN “EXTRA HELP” PROJECT MANAGER IN THE WATERFRONT AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH GOVERNMENT CODE SECTIONS 7522.56 AND 21224

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 7522.56 permits a CalPERS retiree (“Retired Annuitant”) to work for a CalPERS employer under certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with California Government Code Sections 7522.56 and 21224, the City of Redondo Beach must provide CalPERS with a certification resolution when hiring a retired annuitant; and

WHEREAS, a limited duration retired annuitant appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed “extra help” position in the City of Redondo Beach Waterfront and Economic Development Department; and

WHEREAS, the employment shall be limited to 960 hours per fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the compensation paid to retirees cannot be less than the minimum nor exceed the maximum base rate paid to other employees performing comparable duties;

WHEREAS, the maximum base salary for the Project Manager position is \$130 per hour and the minimum base salary for this position is \$40 per hour; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redondo Beach hereby appoints David Biggs as an “extra help” retired annuitant to perform critically needed duties as Project Manager in the Waterfront and Economic Development Department for \$130 per hour, effective April 21, 2026;

WHEREAS, David Biggs has not and will not receive any other benefit incentive, compensation in lieu of benefit or other form of compensation in addition to this hourly pay rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City of Redondo Beach hereby certifies the nature of the appointment of David Biggs as described herein.

SECTION 2. That this appointment is necessary to fill the critically needed “extra help” position in the Waterfront and Economic Development Department as Project Manager for the City of Redondo Beach.

SECTION 3. That this appointment shall be effective April 21, 2026.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and shall enter the same in the Book of Original Resolutions.
