**J.1. FOLLOW-UP DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON RED CURB MODIFICATIONS AND TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES ALONG MEYER LANE (190<sup>TH</sup> TO RALSTON)**

Public Works Director Winje and Traffic Engineer Liu provided a presentation regarding Meyer Lane Red Curbs and Traffic Calming (190<sup>th</sup> to Ralston). The presentation included the following details:

Commissioner Funabashi asked for clarification regarding survey responses.

Traffic Engineer Liu explained the survey results.

Chair Simpson opened the floor to public comments.

1. Cynthia Priebe spoke regarding parking issues, public safety and red zone in her neighborhood and requested the red zone not be reduced.
2. Douglas McAdams spoke regarding parking issues, public safety and red zone in the area and requested the red zone be reduced.
3. Jeremy Douglas spoke in support of traffic calming measures.
4. Michele Aragon spoke regarding public safety, parking issues, and monitoring speed.
5. Lororke Curic and Isabelle Hiedewohl spoke regarding red zones and visibility and requested the red zone not be reduced.
6. Noreen Shaffer spoke regarding parking issues, public safety and red zone in the area and requested the red zone be reduced.
7. Al Shaffer echoed previous comments.
8. Karen Reed spoke in opposition of reducing the red zone.
9. Nick Verhey spoke regarding parking issues and spoke in support of traffic calming measures.

Acting City Engineer Sablan confirmed there were five eComments in opposition and 2 eComments in support and no additional public comments.

Seeing no additional requests to speak, Chair Simpson closed the floor to public comments.

Commissioner Tsao asked if there was data related to violations in the red zone area

Public Works Director Winje stated he can ask the Police Department.

Discussion ensued regarding visibility, parking surveys, traffic calming measures loading zone times and enforcement.

Public Works Director Winje and Traffic Engineer Liu answered the Commissioners' questions and provided clarification.

Motion by Commissioner Funabashi, seconded by Commissioner Beeli, to remove the red zone on the West side of the street and two spots adjacent to the church, change the loading zone start time, and advise Redondo Beach Police Department to increase enforcement in the area. Motion carried unanimously, with no objection:

## **J.2. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON THE INSTALLATION OF A MARKED CROSSWALK ON DEL AMO BOULEVARD AT PAULINA STREET**

Traffic Engineer Liu spoke regarding buffer space and the double-sided yield sign.

Discussion ensued regarding additional signage and striping.

Public Works Director Winje and Traffic Engineer Liu answered the Commissioners' questions and provided clarification.

Chair Simpson opened the floor to public comments.

1. Jeremy Douglas spoke regarding main intersection striping and lighting and spoke in opposition to the item.

Acting City Engineer Sablan confirmed there were no eComments received and no public comments.

Seeing no additional requests to speak, Chair Simpson closed the floor to public comments.

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Commissioner Funabashi spoke in support of the crosswalk.

Motion by Commissioner Tsao, seconded by Commissioner Funabashi, to approve the installation of marked crosswalk across Del Amo Street at the Paulina Avenue intersection except for the reduction of right turn designation. Motion carried unanimously, with no objection:
