
Existing Condition



Background


- Current open-air police shooting range was built during the 1950's
- On October 2017, City Council received and filed a report studying a replacement of the existing range
- Due to the high costs, staff was directed to explore a reduced cost modular option
- In June 2023, during a review of the CIP Program, a potential grant opportunity through a partnership with the United States Air Force was brought up
- Staff was directed to perform planning and pre-engineering work to review the two options

Conceptual Design: 4-Lane Modular Unit



Locally Funded Option : \$5,428,000

Conceptual Design: 7-Lane Modular Unit



Locally Funded Option : \$6,521,000




New Facility - [Meeting Federal Requirements]




Federal Small Arms Range 7-lane Facility: \$17,184,000
