STAFF RECRUITMENT

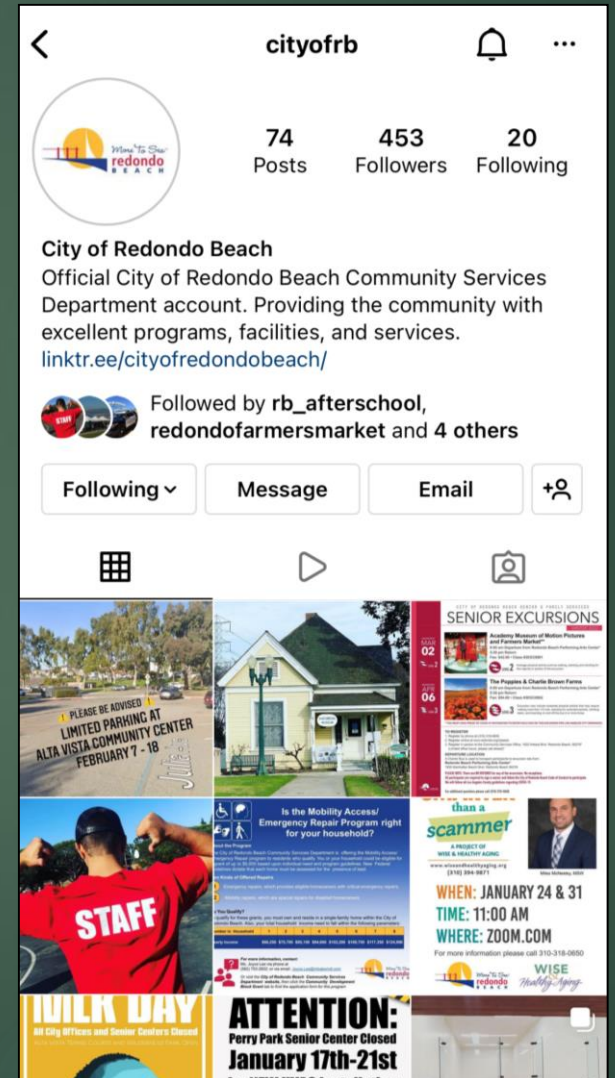
- *Like all California agencies, we continue to experience a shortage of available and qualified staff.*

 - Registration numbers will increase as more staff are hired.



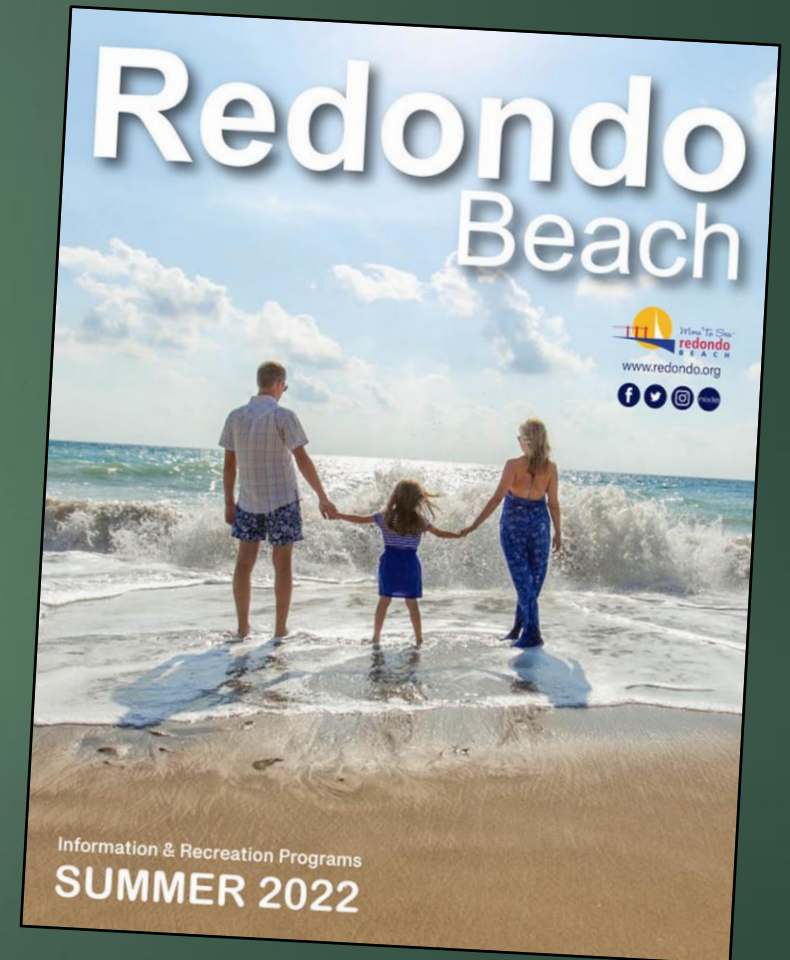
HISTORICAL MUSEUM

- Postcard book is on sale at the Community Services office, located at 1922 Artesia Blvd., for \$20.

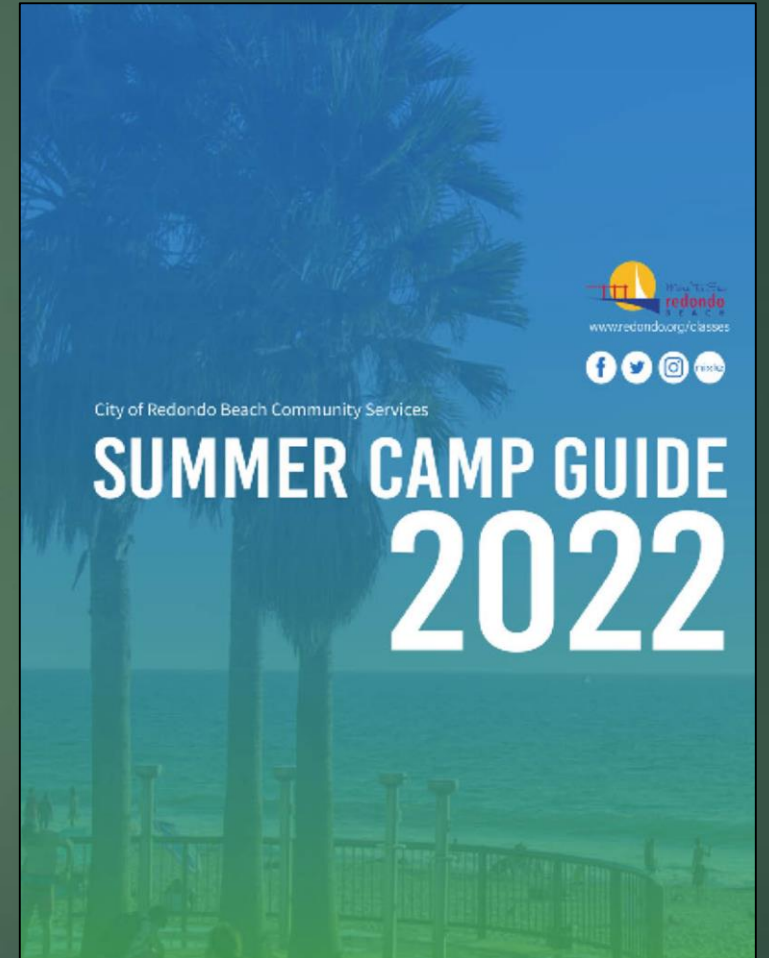
