On January 12, 2021, the City Council adopted Ordinance Nos. 3210-20 and 3211-20 which approved amendments to the City's Planning documents and its LCP to update provisions for Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs) in residential zones, including within the Coastal Zone. The Coastal Act (Pub. Res. Code § 30514(a)) requires that a certified local coastal program and all local implementing ordinances, regulations, and other actions may be amended by the appropriate local government and that such amendments must be certified by the Coastal Commission.

At a Public Hearing on December 8, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. CC-2012-094 certifying consistency of the amendments with the Local Coastal Plan (LCP) and authorizing submittal of the LCP amendment to the California Coastal Commission.
