**MEASURE E OVERTURNS REDONDO'S ORDINANCE TO PROFIT

MEASURE E IS BAD FOR REDONDO**

Provides Fee/Tax Revenue that can be used for Youth Drug Prevention, Homelessness, Police, Fire, and more

Allows Local Control of Cannabis Retailers. How many and where they can go.

Creates Fair Competition with no monopoly

Keep Dispensaries a minimum of 1500 feet away from High Schools and Middle Schools

Allows the City to apply for additional grant funds from the state's cannabis tax dollars

Permanently bans delivery of cannabis from a company outside the city.

Allows young adults (18-20) to buy cannabis without a State Medical Marijuana ID Card

Limits one Dispensary per District

Minimum 1000 feet between Dispensaries

Allows Dispensaries on the Pier

Requires a County Health Permit

Requires a Conditional Use Permit for Public Input

Incentivizes lawsuits

Dispensaries not located in residential zones

Increases Safety requiring Police Department Access to Security Cameras

Dispensaries not within 600 feet of youth centers and Daycares

Dispensaries shall not allow onsite cannabis consumption

Dispensaries shall not sell or allow alcohol and tobacco

Dispensary owners, manager, and employees must undergo background checks

Utilize odor control and air treatment systems

Cannabis packaged and labeled to protect youth

Cannabis independently tested to ensure public health and safety

Easy to modify regulations if determined necessary
