

I am pleased we are finally developing a plan to open our beaches.

following the governors orders our beaches are needed for physical activities and should be open asap and long before other business activities are started back. This is not softening. This is opening for safe distancing activities outdoors for our health.

with good enforcement we should be able to keep the 6 foot rule in place

I think that Phase 1 should allow umbrellas and canopies since shade is important for our health. And stretching in shade is important. Also families need to have children playing in the shade.

while I understand the need to avoid sitting or lying on the beach, people should be able to briefly lay down to stretch and use an umbrella. limiting entrances to the beach is inappropriate since it causes peeps to concentrate and harder to avoid the 6 foot rule. keep access to entrances as open as possible. We do not need to make it so controlled.

IMPORTANT NOTE ABOUT FACE MASKS

they should not be required!!! N95 masks are 95%effective. surgical masks are 50% and homemade cloth is 5% effective at best. It is inconsistent to say that masks are required if not distancing. We should just be distancing and that is required.

I also read in the adm report that you will open parking lots for restaurants and we need some sort of public hearing for this approval. A blanket approval could get out of hand.
