Scope of Work in Base Bid: Bid is based upon (6) mobilizations to complete our work; additional move-ins will be added to our contract price at \$5,000.00 each.

Scope: Clear and grub site of Vegetation and debris. Saw cut and demo AC and PCC onsite as shown. Demo site walls and fencing as shown. Prewater site as needed. Cut/Fill site to plan grades. Overexcavate sitework as required by soils report. Scarify and recompact exposed subgrade soils. Compact soils to 90%. Export surplus soil offsite generated from rough grade operation. Backcut for site walls and ramps. Design and install 2,700 SF of cantilevered shoring for ramp wall work, bid excludes shoring removal. Finish grade pads to tolerance of +/-0.10'.
