RESOLUTION NO. CC-2005-034

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING NEGATIVE DECLARATION NO. 2020-XX-IES-ND-00X FOR THE ADDITION OF A NORTHBOUND RIGHT TURN LANE FROM AVIATION BOULEVARD TO ARTESIA BOULEVARD IN THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redondo Beach considered Negative Declaration No. 2020-XX-IES-MND-00X ("ND"), prepared pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") (Pub. Res. Code §21000 *et seq.*), the CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs §15000 *et seq.*), and the procedures set forth in the ordinances of the City of Redondo Beach to assess and evaluate the potential environmental impacts of the proposed northbound right-turn lane from Aviation Boulevard to Artesia Boulevard (project) in the City of Redondo Beach, at a duly noticed public meeting on May 19, 2020 at which time all interested parties were given an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, the project is included in the City's Capital Improvement Program (Job No. 40780) as an implementation measure of the City's General Plan Circulation Element to improve traffic conditions at the Aviation Boulevard and Artesia Boulevard intersection; and

WHEREAS, the project is included in the South Bay Transportation Project List – Coastal Corridor study completed by the South Bay Cities Council of Governments (SBCCOG); and

WHEREAS, the project is included the SBCCOG Goods Movement Study as a priority one project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project improves regional connectivity by facilitating traffic movement through the intersection; and

WHEREAS, the City circulated and posted on its website a Notice of Availability of the ND, along with the supporting Initial Study, for public review for a period of 30 days from January 13, 2020 to February 13, 2020 pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15073(a) and Redondo Beach Municipal Code Section 10-3.503; and

WHEREAS, the City received comments on the Initial Study/ND during the public comment period; and

WHEREAS, at the public meeting the City Council reviewed and considered the ND along with comments, staff reports, and other materials related to the project..

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby finds that the above recitals are true and correct and incorporates the recitals herein by reference as if set forth in full.
- SECTION 2. That the City Council has considered the Initial Study/ND and all comments received during the comment period and responses to those comments, along with testimony provided during the duly noticed City Council meeting on May 19, 2020.
- SECTION 3. That the City Council hereby finds that the Initial Study/ND has been prepared and circulated in compliance with the provisions of CEQA, the CEQA Guidelines, and the procedures set forth in the ordinances of the City of Redondo Beach.
- SECTION 4. That the City Council hereby finds and determines on the basis of the whole record before it (including the initial study, comments, and responses), that there is no substantial evidence that a proposed northbound right-turn lane from Aviation Boulevard to Artesia Boulevard in the City of Redondo Beach (the project) will have a significant effect on the environment and hereby adopts the ND.
- SECTION 5. That the ND (including the initial study and response to comments), reflects the City Council's independent judgment and analysis.
- SECTION 6: That the custodian of documents and other material which constitute the record of proceedings upon which the decision is based are held by the City Clerk, located at City Hall, 415 Diamond Street, Redondo Beach CA, 90277.
- SECTION 7. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution, shall enter the same in the Book of Resolutions of said City, and shall cause the action of the City Council in adopting the same to be entered in the official minutes of said City Council.
