## SUBJECT: TORRANCE BOULEVARD AT BROADWAY TRAFFIC CONTROL MODIFICATIONS

In response to the City Council's referral to Staff, staff will forward recommendations for the Torrance Boulevard at Broadway intersection at an upcoming City Council meeting. The various alternatives to be discussed include northbound-southbound right-turn only, all-way stop, bulb-outs, roundabout and traffic signal enhancements.

Staff will present the recommendations at a meeting of the City Council on **Tuesday, August 4, 2020 at 6:00 p.m.** Pursuant to Executive Order N-29-20 issued by Governor Newsom, City Council members will participate by teleconference/virtual meeting. City Council meetings are broadcast live through Spectrum Cable, Channel 8, and Frontier Communications, Channel 41 and/or rebroadcast on Wednesday at 3PM and Saturday at 3PM following the date of the meeting. Please indicate which item(s) you would like to speak on and you will be provided a Toll Free number and a Meeting ID to access the meeting. Note; press # to bypass Participant ID. Attendees will be muted until the public participation period is opened. When you are called on to speak, press \*6 to unmute your line. Note, comments from the public are limited to 3 minutes per speaker.

TO PARTICIPATE BY WRITTEN COMMUNICATION BEFORE 3:00PM DAY OF MEETING: Written materials pertaining to matters listed on the posted agenda received after the agenda has been published will be added as supplemental materials under the relevant agenda item. Public comments may be submitted by email to cityclerk@redondo.org. Emails must be received before 3:00 p.m. on the date of the meeting to ensure Council and staff have the ability to review materials prior to the meeting.
