Here are the recommendations we have for the HAPLA position on the Harbor Commission, for the next four year term. This appointee will take the place of Michael Jackson, whose term will expire on September 30, 2016.

- 4) Julian Stern – a young man who ran for a City Council seat and lost, but impressed everyone who heard him speak with his knowledge of the issues and his ability to articulate his ideas. He is a positive young man who is willing to put in the time to study the issues and eager to get involved.
