



Next Steps for Enhanced Response to Homelessness Program

- Continue Program under the City Attorney's Office for the next four years
- Continue Program under a different department
 - Community Services Department
 - City Manager
- Take no action
 - Effectively end program set to terminate in June



Next Steps for Pallet Shelter

- Terminate early with thirty days notice
 - Effectively end program set to terminate in June
- Direct City Attorney's Office to investigate ways to keep Pallet Shelter program going:
 - Alternative Sites
 - Steps needed to keep the Pallet Shelter at the current site
 - Additional funding for ways to keep the Pallet Shelter
