
CDBG Program

- The City receives an annual allocation of CDBG entitlement funds for eligible programs and projects
- HUD has announced the 2021-22 funding amount at \$290,479
- The City is required to complete an Annual Action Plan prior to HUD funding appropriation

Annual Action Plan



2021-22 Total: \$290,479



Public Service Agencies and Proposed Funding

- 1736 Family Crisis Center (\$9,572) Provides counseling, support, and referral services to women and youth who are victims of domestic violence.
- Redondo Beach Salvation Army Meals on Wheels Program (\$6,500) - Provides hot meals delivered to the residences of the elderly and disabled.
- South Bay Family Healthcare Center (\$6,500) Provides free and low-cost dental services to qualified low-income residents of Redondo Beach.
- St. Paul's United Methodist Church Project: NEEDS (\$6,500) Provides meals to those individuals experiencing homelessness
 and food stress; coordinates with City Homeless Services for
 Coordinated Entry System (CES) processing.
- Disability Community Resource Center (\$3,500) Support people with disabilities and seniors to achieve and maintain selfdirected and community based independent lives.
- City Net (\$6,500) Provides navigation assistance for people experiencing chronic homelessness, which includes outreach, case management, housing navigation and referrals.
- Exodus Recovery (\$4,500) Provides resources and skills to achieve and maintain permanent housing for those experiencing homelessness.
