## FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BY AND BETWEEN THE REDONDO BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AND

## THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH REGARDING THE SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER PROGRAM

This First Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding by and between the Redondo Beach Unified School District and the City of Redondo Beach regarding the School Resource Officer Program ("First Amendment") is made between the City of Redondo Beach, a chartered municipal corporation ("City") and the Redondo Beach Unified School District ("District").

WHEREAS, on September 3, 2019, the parties entered into a Memorandum of Understanding regarding the School Resource Officer Program (the "MOU"); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of the MOU and increase the compensation.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants contained herein, and intending to be legally bound, the parties hereby agree to make the following amendments to the MOU:

- 1. <u>Term of MOU</u>. The MOU is hereby amended to extend the expiration date from June 30, 2021 to June 30, 2023.
- 2. <u>Compensation</u>. District agrees to pay \$100,000 annually to City for one (1) additional SRO, listed in section 3. District shall make quarterly payments. The total not to exceed amount is \$400.000.00.
- 3. <u>No Other Amendments.</u> The Agreement and this First Amendment constitute the entire agreement between the parties and supersede any previous oral or written agreement with respect to the subject matter hereof. In the event of any inconsistency between the terms of the Agreement and this First Amendment, the terms of this First amendment shall govern.
