ORDINANCE NO. 0-3219-21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 2-9.101 OF CHAPTER 9, TITLE 2 OF THE REDONDO BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE, ESTABLISHING A MINIMUM NUMBER OF MEETINGS FOR ALL BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to temporarily reduce the number of meetings required to be held by certain Boards and Commissions; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted the City's budget at the June 22, 2021 City Council meeting and it included the temporary reduction of the number of certain board and commission meetings to every other month for a one-year period with the exception of the Planning, Harbor, Budget and Finance, Public Works and Recreation and Parks Commissions.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT OF CODE. Section 2-9.101 of Article 1, Chapter 9, Title 2 of the Redondo Beach Municipal Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"2-9.101 Organization meetings. Chairman.

Each board or commission shall meet as soon after the first day of October of every year as practical for the purpose of organizing. At such organization meeting, the boards and commissions shall organize themselves by electing one of its members to serve as chairman for the ensuing year and one of its members as secretary. Until September 1, 2022, each board or commission shall hold a regular meeting at least once every other month, except that the Planning Commission, Harbor Commission, Budget and Finance Commission, Public Works Commission and Recreation and Parks Commission shall hold a regular meeting at least once each month. From and after September 1, 2022, each board or commission shall hold a regular meeting at least once each month. In addition to any such regular meetings, each board or commission shall hold whatever special meetings may be necessary or convenient to dispose of business without delay. All proceedings of any board or commission shall be open to the public."

SECTION 2. INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS. Any provisions of the Redondo Beach Municipal Code, or appendices thereto, or any other ordinances of the City inconsistent herewith, to the extent of such inconsistencies and no further, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERANCE. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or

more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be published by one insertion in the official newspaper of the City, and the same shall go into effect and be in full force and operation from and after thirty (30) days after its final passage and adoption.
