SUBJECT: COUNCIL DISTRICT 4 - ALL-WAY STOP INSTALLATIONS

During the August 10, 2021 City Council Meeting, the Council determined the consideration of allway stop controls at several intersections throughout the Council District area within District 4 bounded by the roadways of Aviation Blvd, Artesia Blvd, Inglewood Ave and Grant Ave. As part of Council's determination, Staff has been tasked with notifying residents of the potential installation(s) and to solicit feedback. If you've received this notification letter, it is because your residence is within a 150' radius of the six (6) subject one/two-way stop-controlled intersections within the aforementioned area and your input on the matter would be greatly appreciated.
