Commissioner Schaeffer noted this is her 3<sup>rd</sup> year on the Commission and has lived in Redondo Beach almost her entire life. Commissioner Schaeffer commented how she really enjoys the speakers that address the Commission on occasion and the discussions that follow. She would like to see the Commission do more work with the school and BCHD for mental health and educational programs, as she feels it is very important to provide mental health services to students, especially with all this craziness right now.
